Faculty of Animal Science, Veterinary Science and Fisheries, Rampur, Chitwan is pleased to call for proposal for the research grants to its undergraduate students (BVSc & AH and BSc Fisheries) in accordance with its standard guidelines and research norms. The followings are the further points of elaboration regarding proposal preparation:


- a. The proposal has been solely called for the students of 8<sup>th</sup> (5, slots), 6<sup>th</sup> (3 slots) and 4<sup>th</sup> (2 slots) Semester of BVSc & AH and 6<sup>th</sup> (2 slots) and 4<sup>th</sup> (1 slot) semester of BSc Fisheries. The research team must comprise 5 students studying in the same semester.
- b. The maximum budget for each proposal is NRs. 20,000 (Twenty thousand).
- c. Seventy percent (70%) of grant will be provided soon after selection of the research proposal and remaining 30% will be availed after submission of final research report.
- d. The research work should be completed within the current fiscal year 2078/79. The research report must be submitted on or before 15<sup>th</sup> Asadh, 2079.
- e. The research must be supervised by the relevant faculty of FAVF. Same faculty should not be the supervisor of more than 1 group of students.
- f. The study area and experimental animals of the proposed research should include cattle, buffalo, Sheep, Goat, Pig, Rabbit, Poultry and Fishes of AFU Livestock and Fisheries farms. The research areas must relate to veterinary science, animal science and fisheries.
- g. Supervisors are not given any extra remuneration thus budget under such head is not acceptable.
- h. The deadline for submission of research proposal is 20<sup>th</sup> of the Falgun 2078 during office hours.

**Specific Guidelines for Proposal Preparation**

1. Title of the proposal including name and contact detail of candidate (e-mail; telephone) in the title page
2. Introduction (300 words)
3. Objectives (may be included at the end of the introduction)
4. Rational/Justification of the study
5. Materials and methods (400 words maximum)
6. Literature reviews (300 words maximum)
7. Expected outputs
8. Time frame
9. Budget
10. Limitation of the study
11. References
12. Annex information including log frame (if relevant)
13. Work plans
