Faculty of Animal Science, Veterinary Science and Fisherinan Rampur, Chitwan is pleased to call for a proposal for research grants for 4 (four) students provided by the Adventist Development & Relief Agency of Nepal (ADRA Nepal) to Masters students under its standard guidelines and research norms. The following are the further points of elaboration regarding proposal preparation;

a. The proposal has been called for the Master's (MVSc, MSc Ani. Sc.) students who are in their 2nd and 4th

Semester.

b. The research should be supervised by the faculty of FAVF. The thesis research of students will be prioritized in granting the research fund.

e. The proposal must be prepared in any of the following thematic areas-

• Improved Management Practices (Nutritional, Feed, Forage, Hygiene, Quality Milk)

Disease & Parasite Management

• Fertility Management (Repeat Breeding, Infertility etc.).

d. The research must be conducted in **Rupendehi** (Sainamaina Municipality and Kanchan Rural Municipality) and **Kapilbastu** (Budhabhumi and Banganga Municipalities) districts.

e. The research grant for each proposal will be NRs 150,000/- to 200,000 (One Lakh Fifty Thousand to Two Lakhs

only) (including the taxes) based on the nature of the research.

- f. The 40% of the grant will be provided to students soon after the selection of the proposal, 40% after the submission of the Physical & Financial Report and recommendation from FAVF and the remaining 20% will be availed after the presentation of findings and submission of the research report to FAVF.
- g. The research work must be completed within the current fiscal year 2081/82. The research report needs to be submitted before 05 Asadh, 2082.
- h. Supervisors are not given any extra remuneration thus budget under such a heading is not acceptable.
- i. The deadline for submission of the research proposal is March 25, 2025 during office hours.

Specific Guidelines for Proposal Preparation

- 1. Title of the proposal including name and contact detail of candidate (e-mail; telephone) on the title page
- 2. Introduction (400 words)
- 3. Rational/Justification of the study
- 4. Objectives (may be included at the end of the introduction)
- 5. Materials and methods (500 words maximum)
- 6. Literature reviews (500 words maximum)
- 7. Expected outputs
- 8. Time frame
- 9. Budget
- 10. Limitation of the study
- 11. References
- 12. Annex information including log frame (if relevant)
