Insect Collection of Agriculture Science Center, Ghyalchok

Agriculture Science Center, Ghyalchok, Gorkha

The Insect Collection of the Agriculture Science Center, Ghyalchok (ICAG) is an insect museum established within the Agriculture Science Center (ASC) in Ghyalchok. Housed in the center's laboratory, the museum currently hosts more than 500 specimens of different insects. It has gained international recognition for its collection of groundhoppers (Orthoptera: Tetrigidae), housing the holotypes and paratypes of seven species new to science. The museum currently features 20 display boxes onto which specimens are pinned, labeled, and exhibited. Each box is numbered, and each specimen within

it is assigned a unique museum code. The collection also includes insect pests of various crops and is frequently visited by farmers. Originally, the museum was established with a participatory approach, wherein farmers could bring insect pests found in their fields for identification by taxonomists at the center. These specimens were then properly stored for future reference. The museum aims to expand its outreach by establishing collaborations with other museums, universities, and research institutions. We plan to digitize all collections in the museum and upload them to a separate website, facilitating access for students, farmers, and researchers both within and outside the university. We are open to collaborating with all colleges within the university, whereby we can exchange extra copies of specimens to enrich teaching and learning activities.

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


Figure 2. Insert your caption here.

Major Accomplished Activities of DoREX, AFU (2080/081) Directorate of Research and Extension (DoREX), AFU, Rampur, Chitwan

The Directorate of Research and Extension (DoREX) took the initiative to host the First Graduate Conference 2023 at Agriculture and Forestry University (AFU). The conference centered around the theme of "Agricultural Transformation through Education and Research," highlighting the crucial role of academic endeavors in advancing the agricultural sector. From

November 23rd to 25th, young researchers gathered to share insights and discoveries across various fields, including agriculture, livestock science, veterinary science, fisheries, and forestry. With a diverse array of topics covered, the conference facilitated interdisciplinary collaboration and knowledge exchange, fostering a dynamic environment for intellectual growth and innovation. Over the course of the event, more than 100 papers were presented, showcasing the breadth and depth of research undertaken by emerging scholars in the field. DoREX's commitment to organizing such a significant academic gathering underscores its dedication to supporting the next generation of agricultural leaders and promoting sustainable solutions for global food security and environmental conservation.

DoREX has achieved significant milestones in advancing agricultural research and outreach. DoREX has selected 14 internally funded short-term research projects and 11 long-term research projects for the faculties of AFU, promoting interdisciplinary collaboration and addressing key agricultural challenges. Through strategic partnerships with various institutions, including universities, local governments, NGOs, and INGOs, DoREX is leveraging expertise and resources to tackle pressing issues in the sector.

Moreover, DoREX's extension efforts have been particularly noteworthy, with significant investments made in enhancing infrastructure and facilities at its Agriculture Science Centers (ASCs). Notably, in ASC Ghyalchok, DoREX has taken a significant step forward by establishing a biocontrol laboratory and constructing a modern administrative building. Similarly, in ASC Palung, DoREX's focus on research and extension activities related to temperate vegetables and fruits signifies a strategic alignment with the unique agro-climatic conditions of the region. Furthermore, in its continuous pursuit of excellence, DoREX has announced calls for two long-term research projects in the ASCs and 15 short-term research projects in constituent colleges. These initiatives not only provide a platform for harnessing local expertise but also facilitate the generation of actionable insights and solutions that can address the evolving challenges facing the agricultural sector.
